#### **Association By-Laws**

The Board is recommending changes/amendments to the Association's current By-laws. The By-laws will be sent out separately to current HBPA members for consideration. These By-laws will be presented at the January 9, 2019 meeting and the vote will take place at the February 13, 2019 meeting. Changes that are approved will take effect March 1, 2019.

#### **Hispanic/Latinx Health Assessment Survey**

In conjunction with the Spokane Regional Health District, HBPA has applied for and received a \$7,000 grant from Empire Health Services to conduct a survey/study of the health needs of the Hispanic/Latinx community in Spokane and Adams Counties. Once they learned of the grant, Providence Health Care quickly joined in and contributed an additional \$3,000 to conduct this survey. The parameters of the survey are being developed and the community will soon be approached to answer survey questions which will be used to develop additional resources for addressing local health needs in our Hispanic/Latinx community.
